



# Oklahoma City Police Department Public Notice



The Oklahoma City Police Department is participating in an On-site Assessment as part of a voluntary program to achieve Re-Accreditation by verifying that the Police Department meets professional standards.

Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA), the program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations and support services.

As part of the on-site assessment, agency employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a public information session on Monday November 2, 2009 at 5:30pm. The session will be conducted in the Oklahoma City Council Chambers located at City Hall 200 N. Walker, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Agency employees and the public are also invited to offer comments by calling (405) 316-4015 on November 2, 2009 between the hours of 2:00 pm and 4:00 pm. Comments will be taken by the assessment Team.

Telephone Comments as well as appearances at the public information session are limited to 10 minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with the CALEA standards.
